Fireflies at Hong Kong Wetland Park

寂靜的夜空中,螢火蟲浪漫地提燈起舞。你 ┸ 想認識螢火蟲這神秘而又深受愛戴的昆蟲 嗎?香港濕地公園首次舉行「與螢火蟲相遇」展 覽,讓訪客可在熱帶沼澤展覽廊漆黑的環境下近距 離觀賞螢火蟲,更有機會見到螢火蟲幼蟲那忽明忽 暗的亮光!大家亦可透過展覽認識螢火蟲的成長過 程、幼蟲的模樣,以及牠們發光的奧妙。



中國人把荷花視作美的化身。荷花亦是詩人墨客經常描寫的優雅和純潔對象,因為它出污泥而不染,象徵士子清高的風骨,故荷花又被視為「君子之花」。

夏日正是荷花盛開的季節,訪客到訪香港濕地公園的淡水沼澤,除了可欣賞荷花和睡蓮盛放的自然景致外,更可看無數繽紛的「飛行寶石」——蜻蜓及多種漂亮的昆蟲的蹤影。「荷花盛放」節目揭開「昆蟲大合奏」序幕,向訪客送上荷花專題展覽、水生植物導賞、戶外寫生工作坊、荷花攝影導覽、摺紙工作坊及公眾講座等精彩節目。

Lotus is regarded by the Chinese as the symbol of beauty. It has long been exalted by scholars and artists for its elegance and purity. Though emerged from mud, the lotus flower has a uniquely dignified posture. Thus it is known as "The Flower of the Gentleman".

Summer is the time when Lotus blooms most luxuriantly. At the Hong Kong Wetland Park, visitors can see many varieties of Indian Lotus and Water Lilies blooming in the Freshwater Marsh, and encounter many "winged jewels" — dragonflies fluttering along with other beautiful insects. "Lotus Bloom" is a prelude to the "Insect Chorus", presenting delightful activities including Lotus Show and thematic exhibition, guided tours on aquatic plants, Plein Air Painting workshops, photography guide tours, origami workshops and public lecture.

Lotus is known as "The Flower of the Gentleman"



蝴蝶園擴建部分在濕地公園原野漫遊徑側、原有的蝴蝶園對面,面積較大,種植的植物更多,預期將吸引更多蝴蝶來到棲息和覓食。

蝴蝶園除了種植了多種蝴蝶幼蟲的食用植物外,也種植了多種蜜源植物,吸引蝴蝶到訪。此外蝴蝶園的四周種植了各種樹木,組成的樹林彷如屏風,為昆蟲和植物擋風,亦為它們提供理想的棲息地。蝴蝶園內的宛延步道,讓訪客置身在翩翩起舞的蝴蝶群中。

隨著戶外生境逐漸成熟及增加了蝴蝶的食用植物及蜜源植物,自2003年至今,在濕地公園進行的蝴蝶調查已累積記錄了接近150種蝴蝶,佔全港蝴蝶的品種數量超過一半。夏日來到蝴蝶園,相信不難發現金斑蝶(Danaus chrysippus)在馬利筋(Asclepias curassavica)之間翩翩起舞,又或是美鳳蝶(Papilio memnon)在芸香科(Rutaceae)植物附近尋覓配偶。細意留心園內植物的底部,説不定還能發現體型細小的酢漿灰蝶(Zizeeria maha serica)或私弄蝶(Borbo cinnara)正快速穿梭在植物之間。每一個微細的發現積聚起來,就是屬於你的大發現了。

The new extension of Butterfly Garden is located opposite to the original Site by the Wildside Walk of HKWP. Aiming to attract more species of butterflies to inhabit in the park, the extension is larger in size with more plants cultivated.

Nectar and larval food plants are planted at the Butterfly Garden to attract various butterfly species. Trees are also planted at the surrounding area to provide shelters to insects and plants from wind, and to make it a favourable site to butterflies. In order to let visitors have a closer encounter with these flying beauties, a winding boardwalk is built in the new extension.

As habitats in the Park mature, the total number of butterfly species recorded has increased since 2003. Nearly 150 butterfly species have been recorded, covering over half of the total number of butterfly species recorded in Hong Kong. You may find Plain Tigers (*Danaus chrysippus*) dancing around Blood-flowers (*Asclepias curassavica*) while Great Mormons (*Papilio memnon*) searching their partners among plants belonging to the family Rutaceae. Look carefully around and pay attention to small flying creatures. Tiny Pale Grass Blues (*Zizeeria maha serica*) may be flying just around your feet and Formosan Swifts (*Borbo cinnara*) are hopping among small branches. Every trivial observation will merge to become your big discovery.





螞蟻上樹 The Tree Climbing Ants

黑色的雙齒多刺蟻(Polyrhachis dives)喜歡於樹上築建蟻巢。牠們的蟻巢主要以木屑和草葉碎片築成。蟻巢外型像蜂巢,因此常給人誤認。

雙齒多刺蟻以植物和蚜蟲分泌的蜜汁,及小型的 昆蟲為食。由於牠們亦會捕食侵食植物的毛蟲, 對植物來説雙齒多刺蟻是不可多得的守護者。

The Spiny Ants (*Polyrhachis dives*) love to construct their nests in trees using wood flour and chippy leaves. As their nests look like beehives, people often mistake them.

The Spiny Ants feed mainly on the sweet scretion of plants and anphids, as well as small insects. As they also prey on caterpillars which feed on plants, they act like their protectors.

跳躍的蠟蟬 The Jumping Planthopper

每年夏季,以吸食植物汁液為生的廣翅蠟蟬(Ricanid sp.) 會廣泛出現於紅樹林附近。牠們的若蟲會分泌白色的蠟質覆蓋身體,並喜歡四處跳躍。

Every summer Ricanid Planthoppers (*Ricanid* sp.), which feed on plant fluid, appear around the mangroves. The nymphs of Ricanid Planthoppers secrete white wax to cover their bodies, and like hopping around.





改善設施 Visitor Facilities Improvement

為了提供一個舒適的環境給遊客使用,我們不斷致力改善公園內的遊客設施。過去數月,我們於沼澤歷奇內安裝了新的空調系統,使室內的溫度可調整至更舒適的水平。公園戶外各處亦增加了13張自然顏色的座椅,為遊客提供更多休憩地點。此外,我們亦於通往停車場的路旁安裝了10枝太陽能路燈,在提供額外照明時並不需要增加電力的消耗。更多的新設施將會陸續於公園內安裝。

To provide a comfortable environment for our visitors, we have continued to make improvement to our parks' facilities. Over the past few months, additional air conditioners have been installed in the Swamp Adventure to control the indoor temperature to a more comfortable level. 13 new benches with natural colour were also installed in various locations in the Park to provide extra seating places for visitors. Along the roadside leading to the car park, 10 solar powered lights

were added to provide illumination for outdoor areas without spending extra electricity. More new facilities will be installed in the Park in the near future.

傳統工藝製作

精緻的指路牌受到訪客歡迎,並成為公園的新地標。這些指路牌均以傳統木工藝製作,這種技術製作成的木製設施,既美觀,又耐用。而擔任製作的技工,均擁有卅多年經驗,可見每個指路牌的背後,都是心血和功力的體現。

大棠工場:把郊野公園經驗延 至濕地公園

多年來,漁護署郊野公園大棠工場 出產了許多用於山林及郊野的木製 設施。是次濕地公園的指路牌工程, 是技工們首次把山林經驗帶到山下濕 地。剛剛獲得部門30年長期服務獎的 鍾國有先生回憶著製作過程時,談到工 程是一項新挑戰:「濕地公園的指路牌 有別於平常的設施,特別在文字的雕

刻方面。一般指路牌只有繁體中文和英文,但今次 在相同面積的路牌上,便要加上簡體中文和日文。 這在切割字型和上油漆時,都大大增加了難度,因 此製作比以往需要更細緻的手藝。」雖然製作過程 吃力,但看到指路牌豎立於公園內,即時靦腆地笑 說:「頓時感到辛苦的付出已得到回報。」

工程的另一新嘗試是為新指路牌加上栩栩如生的動植物雕塑,展現了漁護署郊野公園北潭涌工場巧奪天工的雕刻技術。高級技工黎輝傳先生一邊介紹他的雕刻工具,一邊細説從前當學徒的故事:「以前,我們用鑿子一刀一刀雕刻出動物。老師只准每一位學員學習一種動物的造型,可是我希望能」,今日,技工可以將雕針套在電動機上進行雕刻,但仍需要配合熟習的手藝才能刻出細緻的造型。「我首先清楚了解動物的造型和神態。接着畫一些比例線,然後才用雕針在木塊上刻上動物。」他高興地表示今次能製作這麼多種動物的造型,證明了小時候的用功沒有白費。看着這些指路牌,黎輝傳臉上流露着滿足的笑容。

New waymarks at Hong Kong Wetland Park have been decorated with lively kingfishers, frogs and butterflies. These humble wooden waymarks together with the lively wooden sculptures have stood solemnly to direct visitors their ways.

Traditional Woodcraft

The beautifully designed waymarks welcomed by visitors have become the landmarks at the Park.

These traditionally crafted waymarks are elegant and durable. The artisans behind all these have more than 30 years of experience and the waymarks are the products of their techniques and artistic manifestation.

Tai Tong Workshop: Manifestation of Countryside Experiences in Wetland Park

This workshop has been producing wooden outdoor animal sculptures and waymarks for Country Parks for many years. This is the first time that their products had been installed in Hong Kong Wetland Park. Mr. CHUNG Kwok-yau, the artisan who has received the certificate of "30 years of meritorious service", on looking back at the production process, admitted that this was a challenge for him, "Generally, information on the waymarks is in Traditional Chinese and English, but

for HKWP, Simplified Chinese and Japanese are also presented. This undoubtedly increased the difficulty on fonts setting, in other words, and we needed to pay extra attention and care when engraving and painting." Despite all these difficulties, when looking at the waymarks standing solemnly at the Park with visitors taking photos by the side, he expressed, "Our efforts were rewarded!"

Pak Tam Chung Workshop: Job Satisfaction derived from Self Creativity

The lively animal sculptures seated on the waymarks showcases the excellence of sculpting craftsmanship of Mr. LAI Fai-chuen of Country Park's Pak Tam Chung Workshop. He was displaying his sculpting tools while telling his story as an apprentice, "In the past, we were taught to use chisels to sculpt animals bit by bit. My master allowed an apprentice to learn modeling one animal at a time, but I wanted to learn the skills of sculpting different types of animals so I stayed after class." Nowadays, although electrical craving machines are available, artisans still have to pratise manually to attain the skills and fine precision of the ratio and

spirit of the animal as "Practice makes Perfect".
"I used to study the form and appearance of the animals, outline the shape before sculpting

them onto the wooden plaques." LAI said. He expressed gladly that those wooden animal sculptures were products of his hard work during his apprenticeship. Looking at the wooden sculptures on the waymarks, LAI smiled with satisfaction.



Our ancestors built houses and reared pigs at wetlands, and hence established homes at wetlands.

Over thousands of years, the formation of Chinese Characters is wise, philosophic and intriguing. Meanwhile, wetlands are regarded as cradles of human culture, and rivers have mothered our great civilisations. Alongside the "McDull at Wetlands" mini-film, visitors can learn about the evolution of other Chinese Characters such as "boat" and "grain" at the Human Culture Gallery, and explore the importance of water to human livelihood since ancient times.







白天,香港濕地公園是一幅生機盎然的圖畫。在夜幕低垂後,濕地公園就變成螢火蟲的世界。寬緣窗螢(Pyrocoelia analis)的前胸背板把頭部完全遮蓋,有兩處半透明的部分在眼睛上方。寬緣窗螢就是靠此兩扇「小窗」透視世界!黃緣雌光螢(Rhagophthalmus motschulskyi)的雄性和雌性在形態上有很大的差別。雌性的形態與幼蟲相似,不會飛行,只等待雄性飛來交配;雄性則不會發光。

寬緣窗螢幼蟲 P. analis larva 螢火蟲要經歷漫長的幼蟲期,才可以破蛹而出、展翅飛翔,在短暫的 生命中完成繁殖一下代的使命。請一起保護螢火蟲及其生境,讓牠們 可以繼續在夜空中飛舞。

Hong Kong Wetland Park is a picture of rich biodiversity during daytime.

At night, the Park is a world of fireflies. *Pyrocoelia analis* has a large pronotum that covers the insect's head completely.

There are two semi-transparent "windows" right above the insect's eyes

on its pronotum that allow *Pyrocoelia analis* to see the world. Male and female *Rhagophthalmus motschulskyi* have completely different appearances. Female *Rhagophthalmus motschulskyi* has a larval appearance, it does not fly but wait for its mate; male *Rhagophthalmus motschulskyi* does not emit light.

- Help to protect the exhibits and don't damage them;
- Don't touch wild birds, their feathers or droppings.
