2. Aim

- Take part in our routine vegetation maintenance works
- Learn about the common wetland plants and invasive exotic species

3. Details

- Learn to use some simple horticultural tools
- Carry out outdoor habitat maintenance works, e.g. weeding and removal of invasive exotic species, at designated sites in the Wetland Reserve

(Remarks: This activity ties in with the "Other Learning Experiences" in the learning category of "Moral and Civic Education" as required in the New Senior Secondary Curriculum.)

7. Points to note

- (a) This activity is conducted in Cantonese only.
- (b) Participants should wear light-colored and long sleeved clothing and trousers for outdoor activities. Participants should also bring along some drinking water, sun block, rain gear and mosquito repellent.
- (c) Participants should follow the instructions of HKWP staff and instructors, and be cautious in handling the apparatus provided. The Park reserves the rights to claim for any damages of the apparatus caused by the participants.
- (d) Since participants are required to participate in outdoor activity, the accompanied school officer shall pay attention to the physical condition of the participants.
