2. Aim

- Learn to be a wetland interpreter
- Serve as voluntary interpreters who provide interpretation to visitors

3. Content

- This activity includes a lecture and a practical session
- Acquire the knowledge and skills required as an interpreter
- Provide interpretation services to visitors at designated locations in the Exhibition Galleries or Wetland Reserve

(Remarks: This activity ties in with the "Other Learning Experiences" in the learning category of "Career-related Experiences" as required in the New Senior Secondary Curriculum)

15-30 (includes 2-5 teachers and officer-in-charge)

5. Time required

2.5 hours





6. Rundown

Activity	Time
Basic training on interpretation skills and related knowledge	40 mins
Serve as a voluntary interpreter and provide interpretation at the Exhibition Galleries or Wetland Reserve	1 hour 30 mins
Sharing and conclusion	20 mins

7. Points to note

- (a) This activity is conducted in Cantonese only.
- (b) Participants should wear light-colored and long sleeved clothing and trousers for outdoor activities. Participants should also bring along some drinking water, sun block, rain gear and mosquito repellent.
- (c) Participants should follow the instructions of HKWP staff and instructors.
- (d) Since participants will be assigned to conduct interpretation in indoor Exhibition Galleries or outdoor Wetland Reserve, the accompanied school officer shall pay attention to the physical condition of the participants.
- (e) In case of inclement weather conditions or the Hong Kong Observatory issues the Thunderstorm Warning, Amber/Red/Black Rainstorm Warning or Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 1/ No. 3 during the activity, all outdoor activities will be switched to indoor gallery visits. When the Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 is hoisted, the Park will be closed and all on-going activities will be terminated.
- (f) To avoid affecting the activity time and rundown, participants should be punctual for the activity.
- (g) Hong Kong Wetland Park reserves all rights about the activity arrangement.
