- How to protect and cherish the nature



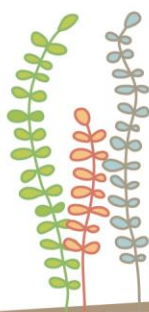
- Recognise wetland is the home of animals

Classroom activity (Duration: 40 minutes) Picture Matching Game <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Observe and experience game 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore different forms of animals Explore the characteristics and behaviour of animals Engage student in role-play session, asking them to pretend specific animals Variety of animals could be found in diverse forms of wetland habitats How to protect and cherish nature
