







Competition Guidelines

The "Love Our Wetlands" Video Competition is organised by Hong Kong Wetland Park (HKWP) and co-organised by The Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups Jockey Club Media 21. The Competition aims to enhance students' understanding on wetland ecology and promote conservation messages.

Eligibility

- Secondary school students in Hong Kong (Each student can only submit one application)
- Each team shall comprise of 2 to 6 students.
 Participating team(s) must be nominated by school.
- A maximum of two teams can be nominated from each school and at least one teacher-in-charge shall be included as a contact person.

- 40% Content Relevance to the theme(s), inspiring and encouraging
- 30% Creativity Innovative and interesting concepts
- 30% Technical Skills Composition, aesthetics and visual effects

Video Content

The video shall deliver at least one of the following 2. messages:

- Wetland Protection
- Importance of Wetlands
- Wetland Biodiversity

Video Format

- The video length must be within 2 minutes
- The format of video must be in AVI, WMV or MPEG4, the resolution must be at least 1920×1080 pixel and the file size must be under 400MB.
- The video style can be in acting, animation or computer-generated imagery. There is no limitation on filming equipment.
- Participants can use Cantonese or English for filming but all videos must include Chinese or English subtitles.
- A brief description of up to 100 words in either Chinese or English must be included for submission.
