A. Draw pictures to show how the tundra looks like in summer and winter in the spaces provided.

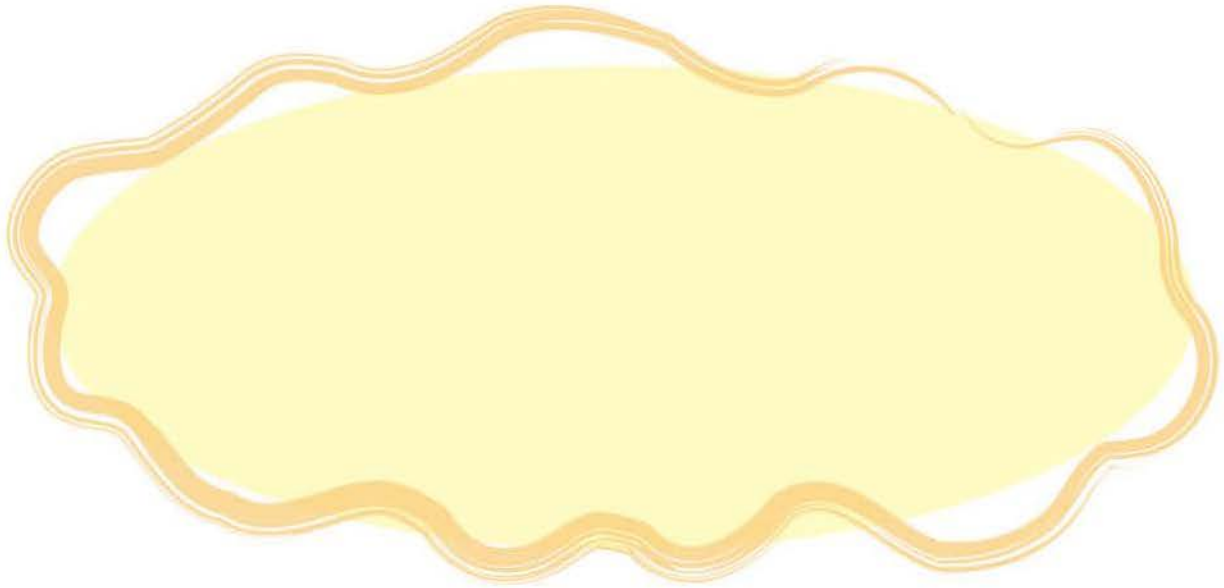
